To help our members celebrate and enjoy this final month of 2024 without any stay and immigration issues in Thailand, please adhere to our following instructions on your arrangements of 90-day reporting and stay extension, if due this month. Please also note that December 5th and 10th, and from December 30th to January 1st, 2025, are Thailand's public holidays, on which our TPC Head Office and all Immigration Offices nationwide will be closed.

Gentle Reminder of Stay Permission and Extension for TPC Members

For an issue-free stay in the Kingdom of Thailand and prevention of any overstay, it is essential for our TPC members to be fully aware of the validity of your stay permission and/or to have it extended before expiration. The following are the eligible periods of stay permission for our TPC members with different types of Thailand Elite visas.

Members holding Privilege Entry Visa (PE)



 1-year stay permission per visit – or less if the validity of your passport or your Thailand Elite visa is less than 1 year – will be granted as an "arrival stamp" in your passport. For a stay longer than one year, an extension of your stay permission requires an "extension stamp" to be affixed in your passport at the Immigration Office in your area of residence, as certification of your stay permission until the date stated in the "extension stamp".

Members holding Special Entry Visa (SE)



 90-day stay permission per visit – or less if the validity of your passport or your Thailand Elite visa is less than 90 days – will be granted as an "arrival stamp" on your passport. For a stay longer than 90 days, an extension of your stay permission requires an "extension stamp" to be affixed in your passport at the Immigration Office in your area of residence as certification of your stay permission until the date stated in the "extension stamp".



In addition to all branches of unique art and culture which have permeated the Thai way of life for as long as anyone can remember.











Before the turn of the year, we therefore would like to take our TPC on an educational cultural trip to gain deeper insights into Thai traditional art in various branches at the following 3 famous Thai culturally rich tourist attractions, to reiterate that Thailand is not only endowed with rich cultural roots, but also continues, preserves, enriches, and embraces contemporary art and culture sustainably with the passing of the years.

Thai Performing Arts - Khon

Let us first take our members to Thailand Cultural Center to be dazzled by the elaborate masked dance of the prestigious Khon performance or the masked dance, as this year 2024 is regarded as another auspicious year for the Thai people to celebrate and honor 2 paramount occasions: firstly, Her Majesty Queen Sirikit the Queen Mother's 92nd birthday on August 12th; and secondly, His Majesty the King's 72nd birthday on July 28th, 2024.

In this regard, the Foundation for the Promotion of Supplementary Occupations and Related Techniques (SUPPORT) has joined in the two royal celebrations by organizing Khon performance of the **"Phra Chakrawatarn"** episode, based on the Ramakien play, setting out from the time when Thotsakan ordered Maris to transform into a golden deer to lure Phra Ram to follow the deer, then kidnapped Nang Sita on a flying chariot to Lanka, which resulted in a war between the army of Phra Ram and Thotsakan. What is also alluring and commendable not less than the exquisite Khon performance itself, is that all of the performers are new-generation youth, who have been painstakingly selected and trained by a seasoned team of dance experts, until they have mastered the required level of elaborate traditional dance skills. During the performance, our members will also have an opportunity to enjoy beautiful and soothing Thai music and singing, while beholding the intricate costumes sported by each fascinating character in the spectacular performance scene of Phra Chakrawatarn, created specially for the grand Khon performance on stage.

Thai Art, Handicrafts, & Agritourism @Jim Thompson Farm

Apart from Thailand's riveting Khon performance, for our members to delve deeper into Thai culture, another area which distinctively reflects Thai cultural richness is Thai handicrafts and art on Thai silk created by Thai wisdom, especially at Jim Thompson, which has taken a step further from its original silk products and exhibitions to the Agritourism project, called "Art on Farm", in collaboration with the Jim Thompson Art Center, inviting artists to create works which blend art, agriculture, and traditional Isan architecture, offering a unique and enriching experience for all and for our members to appreciate intriguing Thai art during your fun Agritourism on Jim Thompson Farm.







This year, the project will be carried out under the theme **"Isan Calling"**, offering a perfect fusion of art, culture, and Isan heritage, connected to the wider world, by bringing together 17 leading artists, many of whom have exhibited at world-class international art events, such as the Thailand Biennale, Chiang Rai (2023), the Venice Biennale (2023), and the Asia Pacific Triennial, Brisbane (2024). These renowned artists, along with guest artists from the Art on Farm project, come from across the country, from the North, Isan, and Central regions, as well as from abroad, who are set to create legendary works of art which deeply connect various cultures within the unique space of the farm, with a key emphasis on local materials, craftsmanship, sustainability, and eco-consciousness. Another unmissable highlight for our members to enjoy for its spellbinding power on the Farm is Molam – the traditional musical performance of Isaan. This year, the Molam performance project, called Molam Rim Thung in the Jim Thompson Farm Tour 2024, will be extra-special, as it will take place at sunset at the edge of the paddy fields, right in front of the Isaan village on Friday, December 20th, 2024 and on Saturday, December 21st, 2024, from 4:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. – the event not only for our members to be culturally inspired, but also to be impressed by the hospitability of Isaan people and the rustic beauty of the paddy fields.



Bangkok Art Biennale (BAB)



For our last recommendation for our members who have always been intrigued by Thai art and who have been seeking more inspirations from the richness of Thai cultural heritage, we would like to take you to Bangkok Art Biennale (BAB) – an international contemporary art festival held every two years in Bangkok, showcasing art works for a period of 4 months and transforming Bangkok into a hub for promoting art, creativity, and international culture. Bangkok Art Biennale exhibitions, which offer free viewing for our members, are held in various art and cultural spaces, including tourist attractions, temples and public places, emphasizing the charm of Bangkok by connecting the Rattanakosin cultural heritage with the city lifestyle, promoting cross-cultural exchange between artists and creative practitioners from all over the world, and organizing various projects to create opportunities for artists to become more well-known.




Interestingly, this free art festival has attracted more than 3.5 million visitors from Thailand and abroad in its past three editions, with more than 300 participating artists from Asia, Europe, America, Oceania and Africa.
